ACHIEVEMENTS AT A GLANCE

- > The Institute has carried out 60 studies to fulfill the objectives laid down while setting up the Institute. With the changing scenario in water sector, the Institute is focusing, on demand driven strategic research.
- > The studies and research in the Institute were carried out under six Scientific themes at the headquarters at Roorkee, four Regional Centres located at Belgaum, Jammu, Kakinada and Sagar and two Centres for Flood Management Studies at Guwahati and Patna. At the headquarters, significant emphasis has been given on basic and applied research and user-defined research while at the Regional Centres, more emphasis was given to field oriented research areas/problems.
- The studies and research carried out by the Institute have received national and international recognition and resulted in the publication of 5 books, 19 chapters in books and 112 research papers in the national and international journals of repute and in proceedings of various national and international conferences, seminars and symposia.
- > The Institute has significantly contributed to the initiation of the Second Phase of World Bank funded Hydrology Project. Keeping in view the contribution made and performance of the Institute in HP-I, the Ministry of Water Resources has given a significant and more proactive role to NIH in HP-II by entrusting the development and customization of Decision Support System for Water Resources Planning and Management.
- > As part of the technology transfer programme of the Institute 13 training courses/workshops and seminars were organized during the year.
- The Institute jointly with the Central Ground Water Board organized the 12th National Symposium on Hydrology with focal theme on groundwater governance: ownership of groundwater and its pricing on 14-15 November, 2006 at New Delhi.
